ORDINANCE 2011-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE OF MANTUA CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 941.17(r) TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS FOR THE SALE OF "BULK WATER".

WHEREAS, the Village of Mantua Service Department has recommended amending Village of Mantua Codified Ordinance Section 941.17(r) in order to establish regulations for the sale of bulk water; and

WHEREAS, this Council now wishes to amend Section 941.17(r) of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Mantua in order to address this recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: Existing Section 941.17(r) of the Village of Mantua Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: Section 941.17(r) of the Village of Mantua Codified Ordinances is hereby enacted as follows:

941.17 USE OF WATER...

(r) Use of Fire Hydrants.

- (1) The fire hydrants are intended primarily for the use of the Fire Department and no interference with such use in any other way will be allowed. Permits for use of fire hydrants for other purposes are given reluctantly and only in cases where such use cannot be avoided.
- (2) Drawing of water from fire hydrants without a permit, by unauthorized persons is strictly prohibited and violations of this rule may cause arrest and fine.
- (3) Bulk water may be sold by the Village at the discretion of the Village Administrator, who will designate hydrant locations from which bulk water will be supplied. Rates for bulk water shall be as set forth in Section 921.02.

SECTION 3: All other provisions of the Village of Mantua Codified Ordinances, including Sections 941.17(a) through (q), shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the

earliest period allowed by law.
