RESOLUTION 2026-07

A RESOLUTION CREATING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF MANTUA TO RECEIVE AND DISBURSE FUNDS RELATED TO THE MATS ROAD BRIDGE PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Mantua has applied to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) for financial assistance through the State of Ohio H2Ohio Grant Program for the Mats Road Bridge Project; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to accumulate resources and track funds related to the project, it is the Village's desire to create a Special Revenue Fund pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 5705.12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Mantua, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

SECTION 1: The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Mantua shall create a Special Revenue Fund named the Mats Road Bridge Project using Fund number 2062.

SECTION 2. The Mats Road Bridge Project Fund #2062 will be used to track revenue and expenses related to the Mats Road Bridge project.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the reason that it is necessary to have a fund in place at the earliest possible time to track receipts and expenses related to the Mats Road Bridge project.
